Dear Petitioner:

This application for extraordinary relief has been docketed but cannot be submitted to the court until the docket fee has been paid or the applicant has been granted leave to proceed without prepayment of fees and costs. In addition, please note that under the Prisoner Litigation Reform Act prisoners are required to pay the full amount of the filing fee. See 28 U.S.C. 1915. The court must assess, and have the warden collect, partial filing fees. There are other requirements of prisoners under the statute. They include, but are not limited to, providing a certified copy of your trust fund statement for the preceding six months, and consenting to the collection of the funds from your account by your custodian.

You will be notified of any further action by the court.
