ORDER

Before the Court is the motion of the defendant for new trial [based] on newly discovered evidence. Defendant was convicted on November 30, 2005 of four counts of violating 26 U.S.C. §7201. In any event, the Court is not persuaded that a new trial should be granted based on the arguments presented.
