Defendant motions the court in notice for renewal of Rule 29 motion for verdict of acquittal.

Defendant motion is timely in that defendant has not yet received the minute entry of the judgment of the court.

The basis for the Rule 29 is that the record is vacant of any evidence of liability statute and regulation making the defendant subject to and liable for the tax resulting in the charge.
