MEDICAL TREATMENT - 1

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4. Defendant requests to be permitted to travel to the Czech Republic to receive medical treatment for the reasons described in the declaration of counsel attached hereto.

5. Defendant reports that she is currently on four waiting lists with various airlines waiting for a ticket to travel to the Czech Republic and that she has to coordinate her travel dates with her doctors and the clinic where she receives treatment. Therefore, the parties hereby stipulate that upon receipt of her airline ticket, defense counsel will provide defendant's dates of travel to the government and file it with the court. Defense counsel will provide defendant's itinerary to pretrial services as soon as defendant obtains her ticket. The parties further stipulate that defendant be permitted to obtain her passport from pretrial services as soon as she obtains her ticket.

6. Defendant's conditions of bond shall be modified so that she is to return her passport to pretrial services in Santa Ana within 4 days of returning to the United States.

DECLARATION

- I, Diane C. Bass declare as follows:
- I am an attorney at law duly licensed to practice law in the Central District of California.
 I am the appointed attorney of record for the defendant in this case.
- 2. Defendant is a citizen of the Czech Republic and resides in the United States as a resident alien.
- 3. Defendant reports that she suffers from multiple life threatening conditions for which she was being treated in Brno, Czech Republic just prior to her arrest in this case.
- 4. Defendant further reports that she is indigent and is not covered by any form of health insurance in the United States. She is however, covered by the health system in the Czech Republic.
- 5. Defendant has returned to the United States after receiving treatment from April 2009 to May 2009 and she reports that the infection has caused damage to all of her vital organs. She therefore needs to return for further treatment.
- 6. Defendant further reports that due to her allergies, defendant is unable to receive treatment in the ordinary fashion but rather must wait several days to a week between treatments so that she does not have an allergic reaction to the treatments. She therefore, requires 60 days for treatment.
