Indeed, he admits that DLP 6 LT 13 purports to hold an interest in the real property at issue in this case; it is thus 7 manifestly a proper party, and the United States properly included DLP LT 13 as a defendant. 8 9 For the foregoing reasons, the United States respectfully requests that Defendant 10 Trustee Elmer P.
