This is the time set for a continued hearing on the issue of production of documents subpoenaed by the government with respect to the above-entitled case. At a hearing held on 9/23/2010 the Corut found Ronald J. McBride and Desiree Saunders in contempt of court. The Court granted a one week extension to allow the parties to produce the requested documents and further ordered the government to submit memorandum on whether counsel should be provided in light of the possible consequences of non-compliance. The Court has reviewed the Government's memorandum, and the CJA Financial Affidavits submitted by Mr.

McBride and Ms. Saunders. After further discussion individually with Mr. McBride and Ms. Saunders, the IT IS ORDERED that counsel be appointed from the Criminal Justice Act Panel to represent Ronald J. McBride and Desiree Saunders. Notification of appointed counsel shall be provided by the CJA Panel Administrator.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED extending the deadline until **10/14/2010 at 11:00 a.m.** for compliance of the government's subpoena to produce documents as to Ronald J. McBride and Desiree Saunders.

The Court excuses government from the courtroom. Ex parte hearing conducted with the defendant and stand by counsel AFPD Susan Anderson. Thereafter, the government returns to the courtroom. The Court discusses the Defendant's Motion to Continue Trial (Doc. 99).

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED granting Defendant's Motion to Continue Trial and Extend Time to File Pretrial Motions (Doc. 99). IT IS FURTHER ORDERED continuing the trial from 12/7/2010 until January 25, 2011 at 9:00 a.m. and continuing the pretrial motion deadline to October 22, 2010.

**IT IS FURTHER ORDERED** that excludable delay under Title 18 U.S.C.§3161(h)(7)(A) and (B)(iv) will commence on12/7/10 through 01/25/11 **Court time: 44 min.**
