

**ORDER**

During the status conference on February 9, 2011, the Court set a firm trial date of **April 19, 2011 at 9:00 a.m.** Defendant Taylor stated that she may seek to retain counsel to represent her in this case. The Court advised Defendant Taylor that the trial date would not be postponed for her representation by new counsel. Defendant Taylor elected months ago to represent herself in this case, after careful warnings by Judge Murguia, and the Court will not delay the resolution of this case for the late arrival of counsel. The Court takes this position in light of the fact that Ms. Taylor has shadow counsel, Susan Anderson, in this case. Ms. Anderson is familiar with the case and fully capable of representing Defendant at trial if Defendant chooses to be represented by a lawyer. Defendant Taylor has the right to counsel if she chooses to exercise that right, but not the right to counsel of her own choosing at the expense of a speedy resolution of this case. Thus, if Ms. Taylor chooses to be represented by counsel at trial and cannot arrange for

1 her own counsel to be ready for trial to begin on **April 19, 2011**, she promptly should  
2 notify Ms. Anderson so that Ms. Anderson may be prepared to represent her at trial.
