17	During the status conference on Februa	ary 9, 2011, the	Court set a firm trial date of
18	April 19, 2011 at 9:00 a.m. Defendant Taylor stated that she may seek to retain counsel		
19	to represent her in this case. The Court advised Defendant Taylor that the trial date		
20	would not be postponed for her representation by new counsel. Defendant Taylor elected		
21	months ago to represent herself in this case, after careful warnings by Judge Murguia, and		
22	the Court will not delay the resolution of this case for the late arrival of counsel. The		
23	Court takes this position in light of the fact that Ms. Taylor has shadow counsel, Susan		
24	Anderson, in this case. Ms. Anderson is familiar with the case and fully capable of		
25	representing Defendant at trial if Defendant chooses to be represented by a lawyer.		
26	Defendant Taylor has the right to counsel if she chooses to exercise that right, but not the		
27	right to counsel of her own choosing at the expense of a speedy resolution of this case.		
28	Thus, if Ms. Taylor chooses to be represented by counsel at trial and cannot arrange for
