[*See* Docket No. 56]. Relatedly, thirty days after either (1) the Court's denial of either or both of the Defendants' Motions, or (2) the Court's granting of either or both of the

Defendants' Motions and Government's compliance with the subsequent order, the parties' pretrial motions shall be due. [See Docket No. 55].

There are two deadlines that should be reset so that they occur after the resolution of the March 14, 2011 motions. First, the Defendants' discovery deadline is February 21, 2011. [*See* Docket No. 51]. This timing is problematic because the extent of the Government's additional discovery impacts what the Defendants must disclose to the Government. Further, since a defense is a response to the Government's allegations, the Government's disclosure will necessarily impact the development of the defense. Second, the parties' deadline for the submission of juror questionnaires and a joint statement of the case is due on March 4, 2011. [*See* Docket No. 39]. Likewise, this deadline is problematic because, without really understanding the Government's allegations, the Defendants cannot fully prepare for this submission deadline.

The Defendants respectfully request that these two deadlines be reset during the hearing on March 14, 2011.

The Government does not oppose this motion.
