16 The United States of America and defendants, by and through its attorneys undersigned,  
17 respectfully request an extension of time to file Joint Proposed Jury Instructions pursuant to the  
18 Court’s Amended Scheduling Order (CR 64.) The government and defendants request an  
19 extension until April 22, 2011. The current deadline is April 15, 2011(CR 64.).

20 Additional time is necessary in order to properly prepare the joint instructions per the  
21 Court’s instructions. Counsel for defendant James R. Parker informed the government that

27 requires that the parties state their reasons for opposing either side’s proposed instructions.

28 Counsels for defendants have been notified about this request, and join in this motion.

1 It is expected that excludable delay under 18 U.S.C. § 3161(h) may occur as a result of  
2 this motion or an order based thereon.
