18 19	JOINT STATEMENT OF THE CASE Defendant James R. Parker is charged in an eight (8) count Indictment with four (4) counts of tax evasion and four (4) counts of making false statements to the Internal Revenue		
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22	Service. His wife, defendant Jaccqueline L. Parker also is charged with two (2) of the four (4)		
23	counts of making false statements.		
24	Because the Indictment is 15 pages long, it will not be read or provided to the jury at the beginning of the trial. Instead, at this stage, the Court will simply summarize the charges and		
25	allegations as set forth in the Indictment. The Indictment is simply the description of the charges		
26	made by the government against the defendants; it is not evidence of anything.		
27	The government alleges that beginning on or about August, 2002, defendant James Parker		
28	attempted to evade the payment of approximat	rely \$1.2 million in taxes owed by him for tax	

1	years 1997, 1998, 2001, and 2002, which represent the first four (4) counts of the Indictment.		
2	It is alleged he evaded payment of taxes by keeping his assets in entities purportedly owned by		
3	his children, and starting in 2004, by misrepresenting his assets and income on forms submitted		
4	to the Internal Revenue Service. The alleged misrepresentations on forms submitted to the		
5	Internal Revenue Service is the basis for the four (4) remaining false statements in the		
6	Indictment. Defendant Jacqueline Parker is charged in two (2) counts with making false		
7	statements on two of the forms submitted to the Internal Revenue Service in 2005.		
8	The defendants have pleaded not guilty to the charges and are presumed innocent unless		
9	proven guilty beyond a reasonable doubt. <sup>1</sup>
