STATUS REPORT

On March 12, 2012, the Court entered an order which granted the United States' summary judgment motion as to all of the tax assessments at issue in the complaint except for the 1997 tax year. In the order, the Court also denied the United States' summary judgment motion on the foreclosure claim relating to the residence that is at issue in the complaint and denied the crossmotion for summary judgment filed by defendant Exeter Trinity Properties, L.L.C. ("Exeter") on that claim.

The parties have not been able to settle or otherwise resolve the remaining issues that were not decided by the Court's March 12, 2012 order. Thus, the United States requests the Court to set the remaining issues for trial and also set dates for pre-trial matters, such as the filing of a proposed pre-trial order. The United States estimates that the trial will likely take two days.

The undersigned Government Counsel is scheduled to be out of the office during the week of August 6, 2012 and also from September 6, 2012 to September 14, 2012. Also, the undersigned has a three (3) day trial scheduled starting on October 16, 2012 in *United States v. Reading*, Civil Number 11-698 (D. 
