### AFFIDAVIT OF REBECCA BEASLEY

I, Rebecca Beasley, am the affiant in this matter and under oath, do solemnly swear as follows:

- 1. I am of the age of majority to make this affidavit.
- 2. I make this declaration in support of Plaintiff's Motion For Summary Judgment Re: Defendant's Liability for Negligent Infliction of Emotional Distress.
- 3. I witnessed John Stuart shoot and kill my husband, Thomas Beasley, on the evening of January 29, 2008.
- 4. On the evening of January 29, 2008, I and Thomas Beasley traveled west on Pinnacle Peak Road in Scottsdale, Arizona.
- 5. While I traveled westbound on Pinnacle Peak Road, a vehicle I would later identify as John Stuart's, sped past several vehicles in the left-hand-lane and upon re-entering the correct lane of traffic cut off the vehicle in which I was traveling.
- 6. At intersection of Tatum Road and Pinnacle Peak Road the vehicle I was in attempted to enter the left-hand-turn-lane. While passing Stuart's vehicle, Stuart began to shout verbal insults and make vulgar hand gestures toward me and my husband.
- 7. Eventually, the vehicle I was in prepared to head south on Tatum, as the vehicle attempted to do so Stuart turned his vehicle in front of the vehicle I was traveling in, so that our vehicle could not move forward.
- 8. At this time, I saw Mr. Beasley get out of the car and approach Stuart's vehicle.
- 9. When Mr. Beasley neared Stuart's vehicle, I witnessed Stuart accelerated his vehicle, put it into reverse, and then accelerated again, it looked as though Stuart was attempting to strike Mr. Beasley or the vehicle I was riding in.

- 10. I observed that upon Mr. Beasley nearing Stuart's vehicle Stuart reached for what I would later learn was a gun. I saw that when Stuart showed the gun to Mr. Beasley, Mr. Beasley walked away from the vehicle with his hands in the air.
- I watched Stuart use his handgun to fire a fatal shot at Mr. Beasley, Stuart then 11. raced away.
- At the time I witnessed my husband's death, I was only a few feet away and 12. experienced fear, extreme shock, pain, grief, emotional agitation, anger and other emotions.
- I immediately exited the vehicle, went to my husband's side, and watched him 13. die in the road.
- 14. Since the shooting, I have experienced the same emotions as well as prolonged grief, loss of sleep, loss of appetite and other disturbances.

I declare under the penalty of perjury that the foregoing is true and correct.

ON 01-29-08 AF 2200 HOURS, I WAS CONTACTED AT HOME BY SERGEDANT KAREN VANCE #44557 TO RESPOND TO TATUM BOLLEYERD AND PINUAGE PERK KOAD TO COMDUCT A HOMICIDE INVESTIGATION. I ARRIVED AT 2245 HOURS AND WE WERE EVENTUALLY BRIEFED BY SERGEARN INTRALING (STI) KEVIN JOHNSON #5176 OF THE CIRCUMINANCES OF EVENTUAL (STI) KEVIN JOHNSON #5176 OF THE VANCE ASSIGNED ME AS THE CASE AGENT. I INTERVIEWED REBECCA BEASLEY AND CYNTHIA CANTRELL.

SHOT DURING THE BRIEFING, I LEARNED THAT VICTIM ORVILLE (TOM) BEASIEY WAS ARGUMENT BETWEEN THE TWO. THIS ARGUMENT STEWMED FROM WOLDS BRING EXCHANGED FROM EACH VEHICLE WHILE WAITING FOR THE LIGHT TO CHANGE AT TATUM AND PINNACLE PEAK ROAD. APTER THE SHOOTING, STURRT LEFT THE SCENE WITH HIS FLANCE CYNTHIA (CINDY) CLANFRELL TO THEIR RESIDENCE LOCATED AT 3540 EAST EXENDITION WAS WITNESSES BALIDED SANGHA AND ALASTAIR STELL FOLLOWED THEN THERE. STUREY WHIT IN THE HOUSE AND THEN LEFT. HE WAS STOPPED AND FLANCED IN CUSTOMY AF PINNELL PEAK AND CAVE CREEK ROAD EX RESPONDING OFFICERS. CANTRELL LEFT THE HOUSE PRICK. TO STUARY THE YER VEHICLE-NAD LATER CALLED-91. WHILE TRANSLING TO HER PATHER'S HOUSE. SHE WAS CONTACTED AT THE 101 AND SCOTTSDALE ROAD REBECCA BEASLEY WAS WITH TOM BEASLEY WHEN THE SHOUTING OCCURRED. THEY WERE TRAYELLING WEST ON PINNACLE PEAK ROAD WHEN A VEHICLE (THAT SHOT MY HUSBAND) PASSED THEN IN THE LIBYT LANE CROSSING THE DOUBLE YELLOW LINES. REBECCA SAID THEY WERE TRAYELLING'S HALLES FRE HOUR BECAUSE SHE NOTED THAY AFTER THE (SUSPECT) VEHICLE PASSED THEN IT HE SPEED LIMIT IS SO MPH ON PINNACLE PEAK ROAD AND THEY WERE TRAYELING S MILES THE OVER THE SPEED LIMIT.

REBECCA SALD THEY GOT TO TAYTUM WHERE THEY WERE GOING TO TURN LEFT (SOUTH). SHE SALD SHE SER THEORIES OVER TO THE DELIVER AND HE ROLLIED DOWN HIS WINDOW AND GAPE HER THE FINGER. HER HUSSAND ROLLIED DOWN ENT WINDOW AND THE SUSPECT SALD, "YOUR WIFE IS A CUNT". REBECCA SALD TOM GOT UPSET AND OPENED HIS DOOR. REBECCA GRABBED TOM AND TOLD HIM, "NO, NO, NO". HE TOLD HER TO LET GO OF HIM.

REBECCA SALD THE SUSPECT THEM POLLED HIS VEHICLE (TOYOTA FU CRUISER)
DIAGONALLY IN FROMT OF THERE ISOU, TOW WENT AROUN THERE, CAR TO HIS
(STURRE'S) WINDOW AND GOT SHOT. I ASKED PREBECA IF SHE SAW WENT HER

I ASKED HER IF SHE SAW THE DRIVER OF THE (SUSPECT) VEHICLE. SHE SALD SHE DID AND WAS TAKEN FROM THE SCENE TO WHERE THE POLICE HAD SOMEONE IN CUSTODY. SHE IDENTIFIED HIM, BUT FOLD ME THAT SHE WANTED TO SEE HIS SPECURES SHE LOCKED AT HIM IN HIS SHES. SHE WAS TOO FAR AWAY TO SHE HIS STADS. I CONTINUED WITH REDRICK, THAT THE PERSON THE POLICE HAD IN CUSTODY LOCKED LIKE THE PERSON THAT SHOW SPED OF TALLGATED HIM. SHE SALD NO. SHE DID SAY THAY CANGHT, UP TO THEM AT THE LIGHT BECAUSE THE STAD NO. SHE DID SAY THEY CANGHT, UP TO THEM AT THE LIGHT BECAUSE THE STAD NO. SHE DID SAY THEY STATEMENT WHIST BALL HER A "CODY". I ASKED THE HUSBAND FILLS THE STAD HIM OFF OR SALD SOME WORDS. REBECCA, SALD SHE FELT LIKE THAT THE GUY (STUDAT) WANTED TO "PISS MY HUSBAND OFF, HE (STUDAT) WANTED TO SAY SOMETHING LIKE YOUR MOTHER'S A WHORE".

I ASKED HER IP SHE REACTED TO STURRY CALLING HER A "CONT". SHE SAID NO, BECAUSE TON WAS LEAVING THE VEHICLE AND SHE WAS TRYING TO RESTRAIN HIM. THAT IS WHEN STURRY PULLED IN FRONT OF HER VEHICLE AND THEN SHOW THEN YERECCA, SAID THIS IS HOW SHE REMEMBERED THE INCLIENT. SHE DID REMEMBER A THEICLE BEEFING HIE HORN DURING THE ALTERCATION, SO THE LIGHT MUST HAVE TURNED GREEN AT ONE POINT.

I ASKED KERECCA IF TOW HAD ANYTHING IN HIS HANDS WHEN HE WENT TOWARDS STUDRE'S VEHICLE. SHE SAID NO. I ASKED HER IF TOM WAS SAXING ANYTHING WHILE GOLDS TOWARD STURKT. SHE KENEMBERED, "YOU CAN'T TALK TO MY MIFFE LIKE TEAT". SHE SAID IT ALL HAPPENED TOO FAST AND TOM WAS "WAD, REALLY MAD". SHE CONTINUED TO SAY HE WAS NOT A "FIGHTING MAN".

I ASKED REBECCA IF THEY WERE DRINKING AT GREASEWOOD FLAT. SHE SAID YES AND TOLD WE THEY EACH HAD ONE AND A HALF JACK AND SODAS. THEY BACH HAD ONE THEY WERE WITH A TOW WEEMS AND SOME PEOPLE THEY MET AT THE PHORMLY OPEN TROW IGWA. SHE DID NOT REMEMBER THEIR NAMES. REBECCA, SAID TOW WORKED ALL DAY FROM 6 AM TO 2:30 PM SHIFT AT CHAKLES SKAD. HE CAME HOME AND GOT HER AND THEY ARRIVED AT THE PHORMLY OPEN SKOND. 3:30 PM. SHE SAID THEY LEFT RECORE THE FOUND THEY DEPENDENT OFFICE THE SUN WERE PULLING

ASKED HER IF TOM SAID SOMETHING TO HER ABOUT STURKY'S CAR PRICK TO ASSING THEM; IE TALLGALING, SPEEDING. SHE SAID, "NO HE JUST FLEW PASTS". SHE REMEMBERED HEARING A VOICE PRICK TO THE SHOOTING FROM STURKY'S

AFTER THE INTERVIEW, I WENT TO HER VEHICLE TO RETRIEVE HER PURSE AND GRARAGE DOOR REMOTE SO SHE COULD GET INTO HER HOUSE. I SAN IN THE FRONT PASSENCHER SEAT A CHECK BOOK BELONGING TO REBECCA BEASLEY WITH "764-VHB TOYOTA FY CRUISER" WRITTEN ON A CHECK.

I DROVE TO 620 WEST WASHINGTON STREET WHERE I INTERVIEWED CYNTHIA CANTEELL. HER INTERVIEW WAS ADDIC/VIDEO RECORDED AND THE FOLLOWING IS A BRIEF SYMOPSIS OF THAT INTERVIEW, THE INTERVIEW STARTED ON 1-30-08 AT 0150 HOURS.

CINDY SAID HER AND STURET WERE HANGING "RON PAUL FOR PRESIDENT" SIGNS AND WERE GOING HOWE ON PITMACLE PEAK ROLD WESTBORND. SHE SAID STUDENT WAS DRIVING AND SHE WAS THE PASSEDSHORK. THEY CAME UP TO TWO CRAS DRIVING SIGNINY. SHE ESTIMATED THEM GOING "20 TO "25" MPH IN A 45"55" MPH ZONE: "STUREY PASSED THEM AND SHE NOTICED BRIGHT LIGHTS COMING FROM ONE OF THE PRINCES THAT PASSED THEM. IN SHE SAID HE KEPT THEM ON ALL THE WAY TO PINNACLE PEAK. SHE HEARD STURKT SAY, "WHAT AN ASSHOLE".

I ASKED HER IF STUART WAS CALM DURING THIS. SHE SALD, "YES, PRETTY CALM".

It is distinctly possible Plaintiff succeeded in a misguided attempt to "teach Mr. Beasley" a lesson, as Mr. Beasley may have consumed enough poison in the few hours before the incident that Mr. Beasley may have been dying of alcohol poisoning at the time of the incident.

32. Denied. Defendant committed NO wrongful conduct. It was not Defendant that allowed a drug addicted alcoholic to drive a vehicle with a B.A.C. of .19. The ONLY wrongful conduct was that of Plaintiff and Mr. Beasley. Defendant's conduct led to the survival of Himself and that of His fiancé, even though they were attacked in their vehicle by a drunken, drugged crazed, psychotic on a murderous rampage.

### COUNT V

### **Negligent infliction of Emotional Distress**

Defendant incorporates by reference all denials and/or statements set forth in the preceding paragraphs as if fully set forth herein.

- 33. Denied. Defendant's behavior was ONLY that which was necessary to survive in a situation created by Plaintiff's gross negligence and criminal acts and in no way breached any common law and/or statutory concepts.
- 34. Denied. Plaintiff's criminal acts caused Plaintiff to experience, hangover, shock and mental anguish.
- 35. Denied. Plaintiff's criminal acts caused great and unnecessary risk to Defendant, Defendant's fiancé, and the public in general.

- 36. Denied. Plaintiff's criminal acts caused Plaintiff's emotional distress, and Plaintiff's continued disavowing of the truth is destroying Plaintiff's body, as doing evil things to innocent people often does. Plaintiff would be better served by telling the truth and facing what she has done to her own life and how her issues with alcohol eventually led to her husband's death.
- 37. Denied. All of Plaintiff's emotional distress and physical illnesses are a direct result of Plaintiff's heinous and criminal activity and Plaintiff's unwillingness to face the truth and face the consequences of her heinous acts. Plaintiff should consider telling the truth, if she can remember anything from that night, as the "soul cleansing" may heal her. Plaintiff's ongoing life built on lies to conceal her guilt will probably continue to erode her health.

### **Assault**
