COMES NOW Elmer P. Vild, Trustee, as stated previously, relying on *Haines v*. *Kerner*, and submits a translation of the document received by this Court on June 18, 2010 as Doc. #93 and ruled upon on December 23, 2010 as Doc. #122. In Doc. #65 "Motion to Comply with Rule 17" received by this Court on February 17, 2010 this Defendant quoted Rule 17 as follows:

Rule 17(c)(2) states:

- (c) MINOR OR INCOMPETENT PERSON.
- (2) Without a Representative. A minor or an incompetent person who does not have a duly appointed representative may sue by a next friend or by a

guardian ad litem. The court must appoint a guardian ad litem — or issue another appropriate order — to protect a minor or incompetent person who is unrepresented in an action. (emphasis added)

It is this Defendant's position that Maria D. Forman comes under the innocent spouse rule and has been incompetent to handle this instant suit or any legal proceedings conducted in the United States. This Defendant believes it is not responsible for Mrs. Forman, does not represent her in this action and has no responsibility to pay for anything related to her including the translation of her Mexican doctor's letter attached hereto.

This Defendant believes in "justice and fair play" and that is why this Defendant paid to have the Mexican doctor's letter translated since the Court did not. This Defendant did not originally submit the doctor's letter as a motion and does not submit its translation as a motion. With the doctor's letter and its translation in the Court record, the Court has the duty under Rule 17 to act upon Mrs. Forman's inability to continue on her own.

DLP LT13 requests that the Court, on its own imitative, without any further delay or input from any other person, Complainant or Defendant, act in accordance with Rule 17 and appoint someone to represent Maria Forman in the settlement procedures with Judge Voss in order that we may proceed with a more inexpensive termination of the instant case.

I am writing this letter to report that the patient MARIA DE FORMAN, who came to see the undersigned due to presenting radicular syndrome secondary to narrow cervical and lumbar canal, refractory to treatment. The patient was given several analgesics in the US, including high doses of morphine. Therefore, an MRI was taken, and microsurgical decompression was suggested, which was done on March 15, 2010. The patient presented an improvement in her symptoms. [However] she is still experiencing residual effects from the morphine; therefore, the patient is in no physical or mental condition to make ordinary or legal decision, due to the effects caused by such medication on a person of her age.
