ORDER
(First Request)

Upon motion of the defendant for first request for a trial continuance, and extension of the pretrial motion deadline, no objection by the government, and good cause appearing,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED continuing the trial of this case from June 1, 2010, to July 13, 2010 at 9:00 a.m. in Phoenix, Arizona.

This court specifically finds that the ends of justice served by taking this action outweigh the best interest of the public and the defendant in a speedy trial. This finding is based on the court's conclusion that the failure to grant such a continuance would unreasonably deny the defendant continuity of counsel and would deny the attorney for defendant the reasonable time necessary for effective preparation, taking into account the exercise of due diligence. 18 U.S.C. § 3161(h)(7)(B)(iv).


IT IS FURTHER ORDERED extending the current pretrial motions deadline until June 7, 2010.

1 IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that any subpoenas previously issued
2 and served in this matter remain in effect and are answerable at the new trial date
3 and the party who served the subpoena should advise the witnesses of the new trial
4 date.

5 IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that excludable delay under Title 18
6 U.S.C. § 3161(h) (7)(A) and (B)(iv) will commence on 6/1/10 through 7/13/10.
