IT IS FURTHER ORDERED striking all documents filed by the defendant while she had appointed counsel.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that excludable delay under Title 18 U.S.C. §3161(h)(7)(A) and (B)(iv) will commence on 10/5/10-12/7/10 for a total of 64 days.
