


1 disclosed tax returns and return information to remain in the sole custody of Movant's advisory
2 counsel at the Federal Public Defender's Office. Movant would have to go to her advisory
3 counsel's office to review the disclosures, but could not retain her own copies to study and
4 analyze. While Movant would apparently be permitted to disclose the information to "defense
5 investigators," this term is not defined and does not obviously or necessarily encompass the
6 various tax consultants, attorneys, and others with whom Movant may consult in the preparation
7 of her defense. Furthermore, disclosure of the information to those with whom she consults on
8 her defense, for the purpose of obtaining their analysis or advice, even if permitted, would be
9 difficult to accomplish effectively without the ability to furnish them with copies
10 of the actual tax returns and return information. The Government's proposed protective order is
11 simply too restrictive in scope and would prejudice Movant's ability to prepare effectively her
12 defense.

13 Movant therefore requests that this Court ensure that the applicable protective order
14 permit her to retain her own copies of the third party tax returns and return information that the
15 Government seeks to disclose, for purposes of review and analysis in aid of her defense. She
16 further requests that the protective order permit her to share the disclosed tax returns and return
17 information, including written copies of the same, with those persons with whom she consults for
18 purposes of preparing her defense. Finally, Movant requests that the protective order permit her
19 to question factual witnesses, with personal knowledge, about the content of the tax returns and
20 return information.

21 WITHOUT PREJUDICE

22 Pursuant to UCC 1-308: "I reserve my right not to be compelled to perform under any
23 contract, commercial agreement or bankruptcy that I did not enter knowingly, voluntarily,
24 and intentionally. And furthermore, I do not and will not accept the liability of the
25 compelled benefit of any unrevealed contract or commercial agreement or bankruptcy". I
26 have made a timely and explicit reservation of my rights and insist that any statutes used in
27 my defense shall be construed to be in harmony with the Common Law.


