1:01 p.m. Reconvene. Jury not present. Final jury instructions are discussed. 1:14 p.m. Recess.

1:19 p.m. Reconvene. Jury present. Final jury instructions are read to the jury. Government's closing argument is presented. 2:35 p.m. Recess.

2:51 p.m. Reconvene. Jury present. Bailiffs are administered the oath to take charge of the jury. Defendant's closing argument is presented. Government's rebuttal closing argument is presented. One alternate juror is chosen by random draw. 4:11 p.m. Jury leaves the courtroom to begin deliberations and court remains in session. 4:13 p.m. Recess.

4:28 p.m. Reconvene. Jury present. The Court is advised that the jury wishes to recess for the day.

4:31 p.m. Jury recesses for the day. Court stands at recess until 4/28/11 at 9:00 a.m.
