PROCEEDINGS: Open Court SEALED

This is the time set for a Motion Hearing regarding Defendant's Motion to Sever (Doc. 74) and Motions to Preclude (Docs. 75 and 76). Also present is retained counsel John McBee for Defendant James R. Parker. Defendant James R. Parker is not present and released.

Oral argument is presented regarding the pending motions. IT IS ORDERED granting Defendant's Motion to Sever (Doc. 74). The Court does not rule on the Motions to Preclude (Docs. 75 and 76 at this time).

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED granting the Motion to Continue Trial (Doc. 84) filed by Defendant James R. Parker. Defendant Jacqueline L. Parker does not have an objection to the continuance. The trial of James R. Parker will proceed first. The parties have until August 26, 2011 to enter into any plea agreements.

LATER: The trial of James R. Parker is continued to November 1, 2011 at 8:30 a.m. and the Final Pretrial Conference is continued to October 28, 2011 at 1:30 p.m. . The trial of Jacqueline R. Parker is continued to November 29, 2011 and the Final Pretrial Conference is continued to November 18, 2011 at 1:30 p.m.

Excludable delay under Title 18 U.S.C. §3161(h)(7)(A) and (B)(iv) will commence on 6/9/2011 until the new trial date as to each defendant.
