The court has before it Terry I. Major's motion to reconsider portions of order entered on July 3rd, 2012 (doc. 80). Major, trustee of defendant Fox Group Trust, requests reconsideration of the order granting plaintiff's motion to strike Major's notice of appearance and ordering Fox Group Trust to file a notice of appearance by an admitted lawyer (doc. 79).

Under LRCiv 7.2(g), a motion for reconsideration will be denied "absent a showing of manifest error or a showing of new facts or legal authority that could not have been brought to its attention earlier with reasonable diligence." Major has not met this burden. He does not provide the court with newly discovered facts or legal authority, nor does he show manifest error. This case is controlled by 28 U.S.C. § 1654 and C.E. Pope Equity Trust v. United States, 818 F.2d 696, 697 (9th Cir. 1987). Rights purportedly granted in a trust agreement cannot override federal law.

IT IS ORDERED DENYING trustee Terry I. Major's motion to reconsider (doc. 80).
