Proceedings: In Chambers: ISSUE OF REPRESENTATION OF PLAINTIFFS

On September 22, 2016, certain Defendants filed an ex parte application for an order (1) staying the deadlines for Defendants’ responses to the First Amended Complaint until such time as all named Defendants have been served; and (2) setting a status conference to set a briefing schedule for anticipated motions and relieve the parties of the obligation to meet and confer with each Plaintiff in advance of filing any motions. (Dkt. No. 16.) Other Defendants filed a joinder. (Dkt. No. 17.)

On September 26, 2016, the District Judge granted Defendants thirty days, up to and including October 26, 2016, to respond to the complaint and referred the case back to this court. (Dkt. No. 70.)

The First Amended Complaint appears to name 51 defendants. Plaintiffs have thus far filed 14 documents entitled “Non-Service Reports” (Dkt. Nos. 22-35) and 34 proofs of service (Dkt. Nos. 36-69).

IT IS ORDERED that a status conference is set for Thursday, October 6, 2016, at 10:00 a.m., before Magistrate Judge Rosenberg.

For case management purposes, and because, as the District Judge noted, the issues presented are the same for each Plaintiff and Defendant, only a representative for Travis Middleton need appear for the Plaintiffs and only a representative from the Attorney General of California need appear for Defendants.

Defense counsel shall use reasonable efforts to serve all Plaintiffs with this order.
