Proceedings: In Chambers: RE NOTICES TO COURT RE SUBMISSION OF CRIMINAL AFFIDAVITS

Various plaintiffs have filed documents entitled “Notice to the Court” “Submission of Criminal Affidavit.” These documents demand a grand jury indictments for various criminal offenses. (Dkt. Nos. 19, 75-79, 81-91.)

The filing of criminal complaints and the pursuit of indictments are in the sole province of the United States Attorney. The court does not have authority to convene a grand jury to investigate criminal offenses by defendants. *United States v. General Dynamics*, 828 F.2d 1356, 1366 (9th Cir. 1987).
