**Proceedings: In Chambers: RE PLAINTIFFS’ STIPULATION FOR TRAVIS MIDDLETON TO APPEAR AND SPEAK FOR AND COMMUNICATE WITH OPPOSING COUNSELS AND THE COURT**

On October 20, 2016, Plaintiffs filed a stipulation, signed by the Plaintiffs, that Travis Middleton (1) may appear, speak and file documents on behalf of all Plaintiffs; and (2) may meet and confer with defense counsel in advance of filing any motions with this court. (Dkt. No. 101.)

IT IS ORDERED that Plaintiffs’ stipulation is GRANTED IN PART AND DENIED IN PART. Plaintiffs’ stipulation is GRANTED IN PART to the extent that the court will consider Middleton’s oral arguments to be in support of all Plaintiffs. Plaintiffs’ stipulation is DENIED to the extent that Plaintiffs shall sign any voluntary dismissal of a particular defendant or defendants. Plaintiffs’ stipulation is DENIED WITHOUT PREJUDICE to the extent it addresses any conference with defense counsel in advance of filing motions. As this court stated on October 6, 2016, the court will discuss the possibility of telephonic pre-motion conferences at the hearing on December 13, 2016. (Dkt. No. 96.)

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
