**ORDER**  
  
(First Request)

Upon motion of the Defendant, no objection by the Government, and good cause appearing,

**IT IS ORDERED granting** Defendant’s Motion to Continue Trial and Pretrial Deadlines (Doc. 14) for the reasons stated in the motion.

This Court specifically finds that the ends of justice served by granting a continuance outweigh the best interests of the public and the Defendant in a speedy trial. This finding is based upon the Court's conclusion that the failure to grant such a continuance would deny the Defendant the reasonable time necessary for effective preparation, taking into account the exercise of due diligence. 18 U.S.C. § 3161(h)(7)(A) and (B)(iv).


**IT IS FURTHER ORDERED** continuing the trial from June 6, 2017 to **August 1, 2017 at 9:00 a.m., in Phoenix, Arizona**, and continuing the pretrial motion deadline until **July 7, 2017**.

**IT IS FINALLY ORDERED** that if any subpoenas were previously issued and

1 served in this matter, that they remain in effect and are answerable at the new trial date  
2 and the party who served the subpoena should advise the witnesses of the trial date.

3 The Court finds excludable delay under 18 U.S.C. §3161(h) from June 7, 2017 to  
4 August 1, 2017.
