**INITIAL APPEARANCE AND ARRAIGNMENT**

3:59 PM Initial Appearance and Arraignment held. Government moves to unseal the case. So Ordered. The Court Conditionally Appoints Retained Attorney Caroline Saunders. The Court advises counsel to file a Notice of Appearance if it is determined they will be representing the Defendant, or to contact chambers if alternate counsel needs to be appointed by **5 PM on Thursday, September 28, 2023**. Brady Announcement given. Counsel requests a hearing. Plea of NOT guilty entered to all pending counts and a denial of the forfeiture allegations. Detention Hearing set for 10/19/2023 at 10:00 AM before Judge Fine in courtroom 303. Defendant to be temporarily detained pending further proceedings.

As required by Rule 5(f), the United States is ordered to produce all information required by *Brady v. Maryland* and its progeny. Not doing so in a timely manner may result in sanctions including exclusion of evidence, adverse jury instructions, dismissal of charges, and contempt proceedings.

Pretrial Motions due within 21 days. **Jury Trial is set for 11/14/2023 at 9:00 AM in courtroom 506 before Judge Brnovich.**
